## MODERN APPRENTICESHIP

### SOCIAL SERVICES AND HEALTH CARE SCQF LEVEL 6

The Modern Apprenticeship consists of a SCQF Level 6 - SVQ in Social Services and Healthcare and Core Skills.

To complete the SVQ the candidate will need to complete the **4 Mandatory Units** and **2 Optional Units**.

#### **Mandatory Units:**

- Support effective communication
- Support the health and safety of yourself and individuals
- Develop your own knowledge and practice
- Support the safeguarding of individuals

#### **Optional Units include:**

- Support individuals to participate in recreational activities
- Support individuals to eat and drink
- Undertake Agreed Pressure Area Care
- Contribute to moving and positioning individuals
- Provide food and drink to promote individuals' health and wellbeing
- Support individuals with their personal care needs
