

MODERN APPRENTICESHIP PROGRAMME





This qualification is aimed at those who work as installers of glass supporting systems, which include window and door units, and basic curtain walling systems etc.

The standard covers the most important aspects of the job. This qualification is at Level 2, and should be taken by those who are fully trained to deal with routine assignments. Candidates should require minimum supervision in undertaking the job.













To achieve the award you must:

- Complete all Mandatory units as shown, plus the required number of units from the selected pathway.
- Complete Core Skills in Numeracy, ICT and Problem Solving at SCQF Level 4 (if you have not already achieved them).

Mandatory Units:

- Maintain health and safety in the workplace
- Transport and handle installation equipment and materials
- Communicating and working with others
- Confirm installation instructions

Mandatory Units, choose either unit:

- Comply with building regulations/standards related to curtain walling in the fenestration industry
- Comply with building regulations / standards for installation in the fenestration industry

Fenestration Installation (Pathway 1) Mandatory Technical

• Install windows doors, conservatories and non-complex curtain walling

Fire-resistant Glazing (Pathway 2) Mandatory Technical

- Install fire-resistant glazing
- Select fire resistant glazing sealants

Fenestration Installation (Pathway 1) Optional Group A (select two units)

- Shape products and ancillaries for installation
- Remove existing windows, doors and panels and prepare apertures
- Prepare and position windows and door sets ready for installation
- Install glass and panels into supporting frames and structures

Fenestration Installation (Pathway 1) Optional Group B (choose any 1 unit)

- Prepare site, equipment and tools for fenestration installation
- Carry out post fenestration installation activity
- Maintain and repair windows/doors/conservatories
- Maintain and repair Curtain Wall installations

Fire-resistant Glazing (Pathway 2) Optional Units (choose and 1 unit)

- Use of fire-resistant glazing in timber screens and doors
- Install fire-resistant glazing in metal door and frame systems
- Use of fire-resistant glass in individual systems
