

MODERN APPRENTICESHIP PROGRAMME



This qualification is aimed at those who work as glaziers, installing glass into frames (e.g. windows, doors), and those who work to maintain glazing installation (usually windows and doors).

This qualification is at Level 3, and should be taken by those who are experienced, capable of dealing with a wide range of problems, including working with complex glazing installations. Candidates may often take a supervisory role in relation to inexperienced workers. They will also work closely with customers and have well-developed customer services skills.



Candidates for this qualification will primarily be: working on customer's premises, maintaining supporting frames and units, installing glass into supporting frames and units. Candidates are likely to have job entitled: Glazier, Fitter, Installer, Glazing Systems Maintainer

GLAZING SCQF LEVEL 6 - UNITS



To achieve the award you must:

- Complete all 3 Mandatory Units and 3 Optional Units
- Complete Core Skills in Numeracy, ICT and Problem Solving at SCQF Level 5 (if you have not already achieved them).

Mandatory Units

- Promote and maintain health and safety in the glazing environment
- Resolve technical problems at glazing sites
- Install glass into glazing systems

Optional Units

- Maintain glazing support systems
- Lead the glazing team on site
- Apply window film / graphics to glass in situ
- Install Fire Resistant Glazing
- Install glass and glazing products to specialist installations
- Install replacement glass within curtain walling systems
- Cut glass in non-routine shapes
- Restore glass surface in situ
