

MODERN APPRENTICESHIP PROGRAMME



This qualification is aimed at those who work as glaziers, installing glass into frames (e.g. windows, doors), and those who work to maintain glazing installation (usually windows and doors).

This qualification is at Level 2, and should be taken by those who are fully trained to deal with routine assignments. Candidates should require minimum supervision in undertaking the job.

The 2 pathways allow candidates to be assessed and prove competence in Glazing Installation (Pathway 1) and/or Glazing maintenance (Pathway 2).



Candidates for this qualification will primarily be: working on customer's premises, maintaining supporting frames and units, installing glass into supporting frames and units. Candidates are likely to have job entitled: Glazier, Fitter, Installer, Glazing Systems Maintainer

GLAZING SCQF LEVEL 5 - UNITS

To achieve the award you must:

- Complete all 5 Mandatory Units and 1 Optional Units
- Complete Core Skills in Numeracy, ICT and Problem Solving at SCQF Level 4 (if you have not already achieved them).

Mandatory Units

- Maintain health and safety within the glazing environment
- Contribute to the work of the glazing team
- Confirm glazing requirements
- Transport and handle glazing materials
- Install glass into glazing systems

Optional Units

Installation Pathway (one unit to be selected):

- Make safe damaged glass on site
- Cut glass for glazing

Maintenance Pathway:

- Maintain glazing systems
