SOCIAL SERVICES & HEALTHCARE **SCQF LEVEL 7**

All Care centres need staff who are able to deliver a high quality standard of care. It is important that staff employed in this area are properly trained in the skills and knowledge required to enhance the life of people they support.

RT Resources Ltd can offer the Social Services and Healthcare Modern Apprenticeship at SCQF Level 7 whilst you are working in a local Care Setting.

It is a requirement of the SSSC that everyone employed within the care sector should be working towards achievement of an SVQ

This SVQ is for those who are currently employed within a care setting and wish to obtain a formal qualification to meet the requirements of their registration.



Suitable candidates should be in the job role which gives them the opportunity to carry out relevant tasks and responsibilities which allow them to gather the necessary evidence.

To complete the SVQ, candidate will need to complete 4 Mandatory Units and 4 Optional units. The optional units will be chosen dependent in the candidate's job role.

To achieve the award you must:

- Complete 8 Units, 4 Mandatory and 4 from the Optional List
- Complete, or have already completed 5 Core Skills

Group A Mandatory Units:

- Promote effective communication
- Promote health, safety and security in the work setting
- Develop your practice through reflection and learning
- Promote the safeguarding of Individuals

Core Skills SCQF L5:

- Communication *
- Working With Others*
- Problem Solving*
- Numeracy
- ICT

*Included in award and not requiring separate Assessment.

Group B Optional Units (4 units must be selected)

- Contribute to the Planning Process With Individuals
- Support Individuals to Plan, Monitor and Review the Delivery of Services
- Support Individuals to Use Services and Facilities
- Support Individuals to Develop and Maintain Social Networks and Relationships
- Promote Positive Behaviour
- Support Individuals To Live At Home
- Support Individuals to Retain, Regain and Develop Skills to Manage Their Daily Living
- Implement Development Activities to Meet Individuals' Goals, Preferences and Needs
- Support Individuals to Continue Therapies
- Support Individuals with Specific Communication Needs
- Support Individuals to Manage Change in Their Lives
- Carry Out Extended Feeding Techniques to Ensure Individuals Nutritional and Fluid Intake
- Undertake Routine Clinical Measurements
- Move and Position Individuals
- Administer Medication to Individuals
- Undertake Tissue Viability Risk Assessment for Individuals
