ADMINISTRATION OF MEDICATION SCQF 7

The PDA in Health and Social Care: Administration of Medicine is a qualification which provides knowledge and skills to those who administer medicine, and also provides CPD opportunities for those who have to demonstrate that they have updated and maintained their practice. The qualification has links to SVQs in Health and Social Care at levels 3 and 4.

The target audience for the PDA in Health and Social Care: Administration of Medicine includes the following groups:

- those who are involved in administering medication in social services and related settings
- residential care workers
- support workers and day care workers in services for older people, children and young people, mental health, care at home and housing support
- personal assistants



The PDA is achieved on the successful attainment of two mandatory Units:

- Administration of Medication
- Administer Medication to Individuals

The 16 week course is based on 40 hours of Open Learning and is a candidate led award. RT Resources Ltd will provide ongoing Assessor support via email and phone. To achieve the award, learners must complete all activities within a workbook and construct a 2000-2500 “integrated” word essay, and provide SVQ evidence as a reflective account.

To ensure completion of award, learners need to allocate an average of 3 - 4 hours per week study time.
